The Process (Preparing the Plan)

The **Broadway 360° Development Plan** is the product of an unprecedented 10-month, three-phase community consultation process.

Phase One – Connecting with the Community

- ❖ Creative Planning for Extensive Community Consultation
- ❖ Interactive Exhibits collecting data at the Fringe Festival and Broadway Street Fair (2008)
- ❖ Community Summit: Connecting with the Community & Getting Feedback
- ❖ Site analysis and meetings with stakeholder Focus Groups: Business Owners, Churches, Commercial Land Owners, Heritage, Residents, and Schools
- ❖ Broadway 360° Summit (Oskayak School – September 2008)

Phase Two – Sharpening the Vision

- ❖ Walk'n'Talk
- ❖ Forum Closing (Oskayak School – October 2008)

Phase Three – Refining the Plan

The Process (Implementing the Plan)

Phase Four – The Last Two Years

- ❖ Steering Committee meets to prioritize recommendations (February 2010)
- ❖ Steering Committee reconvenes to discuss implementation (June 2010)
- ❖ Steering Committee and City of Saskatoon planning staff meet to discuss details and implications of a new B5B Zoning District and Architectural Control District (June 2010 – September 2011)
- ❖ Harold Madi visits at the request of the Nutana Community Association (February/March 2011)
- ❖ Consensus reached on amendments that will go forward (June 2011)
- ❖ Open House – January 19, 2012
- ❖ Technical Workshop – January 24, 2012
