# PAYROLL TAXES AND PROPERTY TAXES

On January 1, CPP premiums rose to 7.3% due to an increase in both the CPP rate and the Yearly Maximum Pensionable Earnings (YMPE), costing workers and employers up to \$255 more in contributions per employee. The self-employed contribution rate has also increased to 11.9% (from 11.4%).

Employment Insurance (EI) premium increases for employers as much as 5.2% per employee also changed as of January 1st. Together, the increases in CPP and EI will cost businesses up to \$325 more per employee – a 6.7% increase from 2022.

## Property Tax Assessment – Notices, Reviews and Appeals

The City of Saskatoon's 2023 Assessment Roll is now open for review. The 30-Day Assessment Review and the appeal period has started and will run until February 3, 2023. You may have received a 2023 Assessment Notice by mail - only if there has been a change since January 1, 2022, to a property's assessment, tax status or ownership.

### Reviews

You can review the Assessment Roll in person at the Assessment and Valuation Office at 325 Third Ave North (one block north of City Hall) weekdays 8 AM-5 PM or view it online at [saskatoon.ca/taxtool](https://saskatoon.ca/taxtool).

### Appeals

If you would like to proceed with filing a formal appeal with the City's Board of Revision regarding the valuation, classification or content of your property's assessment, your Notice of Appeal and the accompanying fee must be received before February 3, 2023. To download a Notice of Appeal form, visit [saskatoon.ca/assessmentappeals](https://saskatoon.ca/assessmentappeals).

# SNOW REMOVAL SHOVEL YOUR SNOW ONTO THE STREET!

In the Broadway District (and all BID areas in Saskatoon), the City allows for shoveling snow directly onto the street because our streets are prioritized for snow clearing.

Private parking lots cannot move their snow onto roadways just for pedestrian-area snow clearing.

If your landlord or property manager has a third party that takes care of snow clearing, be sure to tell them that the sidewalks and the amenities strip needs to be cleared of snow within 72 hours.
